Profile of Child	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Child is in Crisis. ▪ Child is a new client.(Existing clients can access crisis service array while remaining in their current SP). ▪ Following stabilization of the crisis episode, the child will be re-assessed and assigned to the LOC-R at the time of that assessment . ▪ Transition to SP 1, 2, 3, or 4 will likely <i>require</i>: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Crisis Intervention Services ▪ ANY or ALL services available in the crisis array as clinically indicated for crisis stabilization. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Stable Presentation. ▪ Variety of Diagnosis/history of symptoms. ▪ Child may be transitioning down from SP 2, SP 3, or 4. ▪ Needs can be met with Routine Case Management and Medication Management 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Stable family and life domain functioning. ▪ Less complex needs (behavioral OR emotional). ▪ Child may be transitioning from SP 3 or SP 4. ▪ Can Benefit from Routine Case Management, Medication Management AND ▪ Transition to lower SP and/or recovery will likely <i>require</i>: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Counseling OR ▪ Skills Training AND ▪ Other Core Services as clinically indicated. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Child has Complex (behavioral AND emotional) needs, and may likely have risk behaviors indicating an array of services. ▪ Child may likely have multiple life domain functioning symptoms and/or caregiver needs. ▪ Child may be transitioning down from SP4. ▪ Can Benefit from Case Management and/or Medication Management AND ▪ Transition to lower SP and/or recovery will likely <i>require</i>: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Counseling AND ▪ Skills Training AND ▪ Other Core Services as clinically indicated. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Child likely has severe multiple system involvement. ▪ Child likely has multiple severe life domain functioning symptoms, caregiver needs, behavioral and/or emotional needs. ▪ Child has a high severity of risk behaviors likely to result in juvenile justice involvement, expulsion from school, displacement from home and/or serious injury to self or others, or death. ▪ May benefit from Medication Management ▪ Stabilization and transition to lower SP will likely <i>require</i>: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Counseling AND/OR ▪ Skills Training AND ▪ Intensive Case Management <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Wraparound Process ▪ 24/7 accessibility to Wraparound Team AND ▪ Other Core Services as clinically indicated. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Child has emotional, behavioral and/or developmental needs. ▪ Child is between 3 and 5 years of age or is developmentally within this age range. ▪ Can benefit from Case Management (Routine or Intensive as clinically indicated). ▪ Recovery will likely <i>require</i>: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Counseling (Dyad Therapy) AND/OR ▪ Skills Training AND ▪ Other Core Services as clinically indicated.
